Starting Line:

Between Fairlie Racing Mark 'K' off Largs Yacht Haven, and a staff flying an orange pennant on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag moored adjacent.

Course: *From FAIRLIE to TARBERT leaving the COMMITTEE VESSEL to PORT, via the TANN leaving GREAT CUMBRAE and BUTE to STBD, and INCHMARNOCK, ARDLAMONT SHELF BUOY (No 47) and SGAT MOR (Skate Island) to PORT.*

Finish: A line between a staff flying a blue pennant on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag (anchored approx 400m E of Tarbert Pier) and Garbhaird Point.

(If the Committee vessel is not on station, yachts should record their finish time and position amongst other finishing yachts when the East face of Tarbert old stone pier (Rhubha Loisgte) bears 180deg within 100 metres. A smart phone photo of the pier will assist the Race Committee in compiling the results)

All competitors are warned of SHALLOW WATER adjacent to the Finish Line

Time Limit: The time limit for all Classes will be 1700hrs, with a half hour extension for any Class where a yacht of that Class has finished before 1700hrs
